Title: Support of Skinakas Observatory operations in complementing radio observations of compact symmetric objects with optical observations

Job Description

We seek one PhD student to perform optical observations, including polarimetric observations, to analyze and interpret optical data on compact symmetric objects, in conjunction with radio observations

Required qualifications

The successful candidate needs to

- be enrolled in a Ph.D. program in Astrophysics
- have a Masters degree in Astrophysics.
- have prior experience with optical polarimetric observations

The successful candidate must be available to start and be present in Crete by the starting date.

Evaluation Criteria

- Grade on MS Degree in Astrophysics (50%)
- Experience with polarimetric observations (50%)
- Research experience on compact symmetric objects

Evaluation procedure

Applications will be evaluated by a three-member evaluation committee. In case of interview procedure, applicants will be invited to participate in person or teleconference.

In case of titles and qualifications awarded by foreign Higher Education Institutions, the provisions of the Law 55/2023 (article 36) and 4957/2022 (article 304) are implemented.

The results of the selection will be announced on the website of IMBB-FORTH.
